General Info:

Thank you for your interest in Aerybeth Sewing classes. What a wonderful investment in yourself or your child. They will truly 'Learn a Skill that Lasts a Lifetime!'

Summer Camps:

- Camps are Monday Thursday 9 am till 12 noon.
- On Thursday each of the camps will have an extra hour for some extra fun activities (9 am till 1 pm)
- Choose one or more of the camps you would like to sign your child up for on the registration form.
- Camps are Ages 8 and up unless stated as a TEEN/TWEEN camp and then the camp is ages 11 and up. If you have an ALMOST 8 year old and they would like to attend camp, then message me to set up a Mom and me class for you both to evaluate your child's skill and attention.
- Camps are for girls only. However, if you have a son that would like to take classes please contact me to set up a lesson for you and your son.
- Payment is expected at time of registration to hold your spot. (Venmo, CashApp, Cash or Check)
- Camps are limited to a MAX of 6 girls per camp. I teach out of my home sewing studio (for over 16 years) and I have found that they learn BEST in smaller groups!
- All Campers need to bring 1 tshirt without pockets in their size. Any color they like
- All camps include all supplies (except for the tee 3)
- Camps also include snacks, lemonade and water. If your child is allergic to anything please list on registration form. If your child has a special diet please bring their special snack to camp.
- Your child does NOT need a sewing machine for camp. You can rent a machine for the week for \$10 for the entire week. Although if they have one, please bring to camp. It will stay here for the duration of camp. It is best to learn on the machine that they will use at home.

Fall Classes for Girls – Fall 2024 \$90 a month Ages 8 up to 17 (after 18 adult classes available)

Ongoing classes are different than the Summer Fun Sewing Camps. Each student (adult or child) needs their own sewing machine, tools and supplies. No one can improve if you do not practice - just like a musical instrument!

If you need suggestions just ask or take a look at my SHOP page on the <u>www.aerybeth.com</u> website! There are suggestions there for sewing machines that work best for children and beginner adults. If you have questions just ask. You do NOT need all the tools shown, ask before you purchase!

- Ongoing classes have a once a year registration of \$40. This fee holds your spot for the fall and helps with the costs of printouts, and supplies often forgotten. If your child does forget supplies and I have some available I will send out a venmo invoice for supplies used.
- Students will bring their sewing machine, tools and supplies to each class
- A supply list for upcoming projects will be sent out so you can purchase ahead of time. I send it out at least 2 weeks before the class and most often a month ahead.
- To register for fall classes, PLEASE COMPLETE FORM AND PAY \$40 THRU VENMO(@aerybeth) OR Cash App (\$aerybeth) or Drop off or mail check or cash. Checks made payable to Cristy Anderson

- Tuition for **ongoing classes** are due the FIRST WEEK of each month. Late fee of \$20 can be added to tuition after the 7th day of the month. If you are having difficulty please let me know!
- *There are NO make-up sessions for classes missed for ongoing classes. We "make up" the class by having a Private session 30 minute to 1 hour add on to the next class either before (30 min prior) or after(30 min after) regular scheduled class. I have classes most days so there isn't time. Occasionally I can fit a student in on another day if we are on the same project and I have space.
- Since Private Lessons are a higher fee, a one hour make up lesson takes the place of a 2 hour class with others. Also, we can accomplish much more in a shorter period of time.
- If your student misses more than one class per semester there will be an additional fee for private makeup sessions.

Stand Alone Classes (Private with 1 or 2 family members)

- Stand Alone classes are not ongoing classes. These are classes that I teach around my ongoing classes.
- You choose a class to attend once and then can schedule additional classes as needed/desired.
- Stand Alone classes scheduled ahead of time and minimum 1/2 of class fee is required to hold your spot.
- The remainder of the fee will be due on or before your scheduled class.
- **If you cancel 1-3 days before your scheduled class there is no refund for your down payment.** Depending on the circumstance, such as a true unforeseen emergency, we can possibly reschedule. If you claim a day and then cancel, you have taken a spot from another that might want to learn and made it difficult for me to fill that spot with such limited amount of time. I hope this makes sense :)
- **Private lessons are \$30 per hour.** If we have a class that goes past the time originally thought then payment for the extra time will be billed at the end of class. (example a 2 hour class extends to 2 ½ hours payment is \$75)

Registration:

- After filling out the form you will receive a confirmation email within 24-48 hours.
- After registration is received you will receive an invoice for payment to hold your spot
- The Hold Harmless agreement is required at the bottom of the form.
- I will email a pdf form that you will sign and bring on the first day of class. This is my emergency contact form to have on hand during class.
